1	Scope of Work
	<p>a) The LCEPL here by assigns work for the excavation, lowering, laying, jointing, fixing, refilling, disposing, dewatering and constructing of various under ground drainage works on the fixed rates, without any escalation agreed & acceptable by the sub-contractor. Detail Engineering, Inspection, loading, unloading, transportation, safe keeping, supply of materials (If any), UGD Work and all associated by works at UGD Network & STP in Solapur Municipal Corporation, Indrabhavan, Punyashlok Abasaheb Varadpath, Railway LInes, Solapur - 413001</p> <p>b) The sub contractor shall perform all inspection and expediting as per approved quality assurance plan for the entire work. sub-contractor's scope of work shall include inspection of all materials, equipment and work that comprise or will comprise the work order. The sub-contractor shall be fully responsible for the progress of work and completion and the quality of the work in accordance with this work order. LCEPL, CLIENT and their designated representatives shall have the right to monitor the progress of the work and to inspect and review such works at all reasonable times. LCEPL reserves the right to reject or to direct sub-contractor to reject any or all items of Supplies and work that are out of compliance with this work order.
